Attendees are expected to be primarily professionals (paid and volunteer) active in teaching dog training skills to dog owners. Presentations should present information or techniques that will enhance the ability of the audience members to:

1. Teach people
2. Train or manage dogs
3. Develop or maintain businesses

The above encompasses a wide range of topics, including but not limited to, public speaking/class presentation and management; interpersonal communications; business ethics; canine body language/communication; adult learning theory; human learning styles; canine learning theory; training methods; canine behavior - shyness, aggression; remote collar use; nutrition; relationship between disease and behavior issues; dog sports including but not limited to: agility, competition obedience, rally, tracking/nosework, flyball, tricks and games; SAR training; service and therapy dog/handler training; working with clients with disabilities; emergency care/first aid; techniques for training handicapped dogs such as deaf or blind dogs; alternative therapies in relation to canine behavior like flower essences, acupressure or massage.
